Sealed bids will be received by the Pueblo of Zia at the Information Desk located at the Capital Building, 135 Capitol Square Drive, Zia Pueblo, NM 87053 for the project described below no later than 2:00 pm local time, September 28, 2020. The public opening and reading of bids will commence shortly after close of bid time at this location. Delivery of bids to the Pueblo of Zia is the sole responsibility of the Bidders.

Potential Bidders are required to fill out and submit the project-specific Acknowledgement of Receipt Form and return via email to the engineer of record to receive further communications including amendments/addenda to the bid documents. Please follow the return instructions on each project-specific Acknowledgement of Receipt Form. It is the Contractor's responsibility to obtain all amendments/addenda from the website prior to the bid opening.

A Pre-Bid conference will be held at 2:00 pm on September 21, 2020 at the General Conference Room, 135 Capitol Square Drive, Zia Pueblo, NM 87053. Attendance by contractors intending on submitting a bid is not required in accordance with Instructions to Bidders. Suppliers or subcontractors are encouraged but not required to attend.

Description of Project: The base bid project consists of construction and tie-in of a 24" irrigation transmission line of 624 linear feet of pipe, construction of a river aerial crossing consisting of structural concrete, 30" drilled shaft foundation, and prefabricated steel truss, stabilization of the Jemez River bank at the aerial crossing, construction of a winged headwall, and demolition of the existing 24" line of 624 linear feet, existing winged headwall, existing aerial crossing pile, and existing substructure concrete. The project is located 2.5 miles northwest of the Pueblo of Zia proper in Zia Pueblo, New Mexico. The irrigation transmission line begins at the same location of the outlet distribution box at the Zia Lake impoundment. The line proceed to the southwest, aerially crosses the Jemez River and ends at the same location of a concrete headwall downstream. Additive Alternate 1 consists of the construction of an additional 24" ductile iron irrigation transmission line of 1,594 linear feet of pipe and demolition of the existing 24" line of 1,594 linear feet. Additive Alternate 2 includes cured in place pipe lining of 175 linear feet of 24" irrigation transmission line.

All work shall be completed in accordance with the New Mexico APWA Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction latest edition, the New Mexico State Department of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway and Bridge Construction latest edition, and the latest applicable local, state, and federal codes.

Owner will select the most responsive, responsible low bidder based on the Base Bid plus Additive Alternate #1, and consideration of other additive alternate bids that serve the best interest of the Owner. The owner reserves the right to reject all bids.

The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the specifications.
